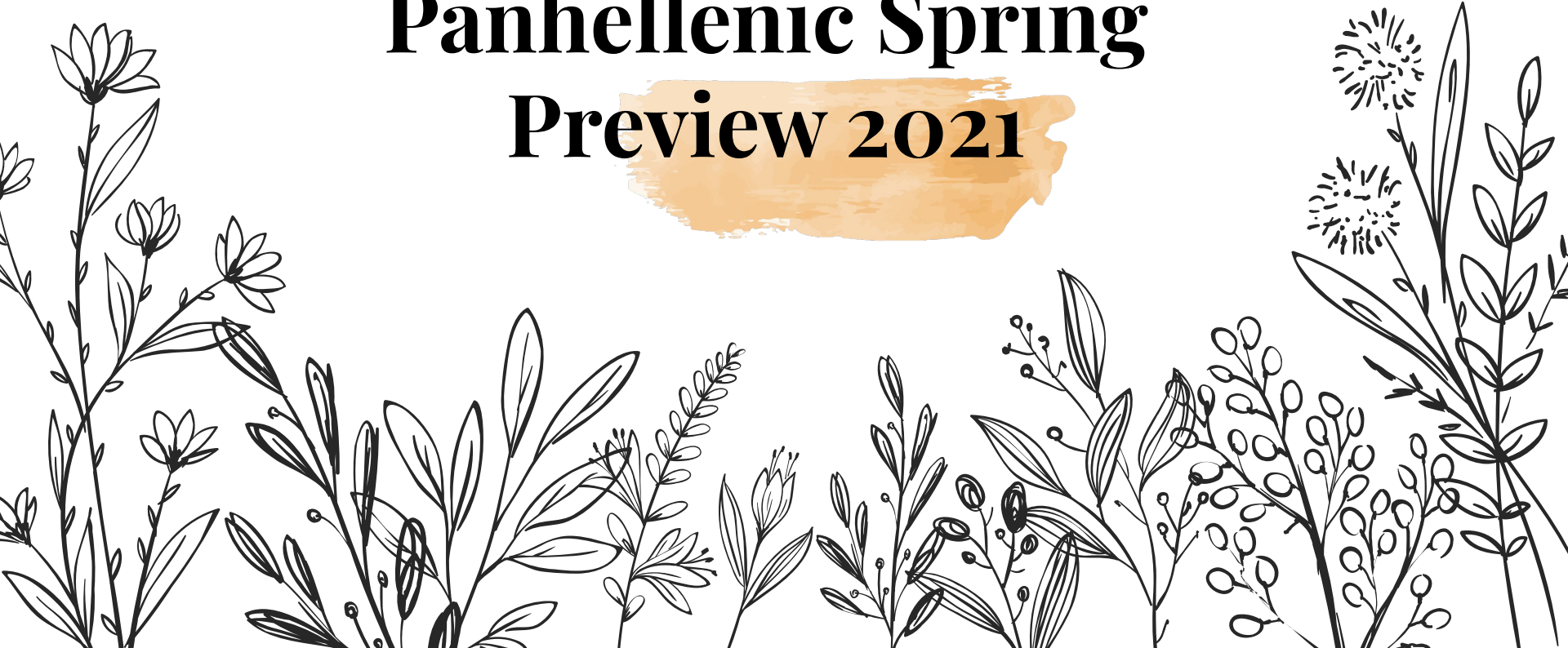

- As a potential member, you get to meet a variety of women from the chapter in a relaxed setting, ask your questions and learn more about the organization and its members
- It is up to you which chapters and events you want to go to



Potential New Member Bill of Rights



- The right to be treated as an individual
- The right to be fully informed about the recruitment process
- The right to ask questions and receive true and objective answers from recruitment counselors and members
- The right to be treated with respect
- The right to be treated as a capable and mature person without being patronized
- The right to ask how and why and receive straight answers
- The right to have and express opinions to the Panhellenic Recruitment team
- The right to have inviolable confidentiality when sharing information with the Panhellenic Recruitment team
- The right to make informed choices without undue pressure from others
- The right to be fully informed about the NPC Unanimous Agreements implicit in the continuous open bidding acceptance binding agreement (COBABA) signing process
- The right to make one's own choice and decision and accept full responsibility for the results of that decision
- The right to have a positive, safe and enriching recruitment and new member experience

COBABA

- Continuous Open Bidding Acceptance Binding Agreement
- You will sign immediately after accepting your bid
- Binds you to that sorority for a year, even if you resign during the new member process
- Other bids extended to you become null after you complete the form for the sorority you join
